Fundraising/MSSS

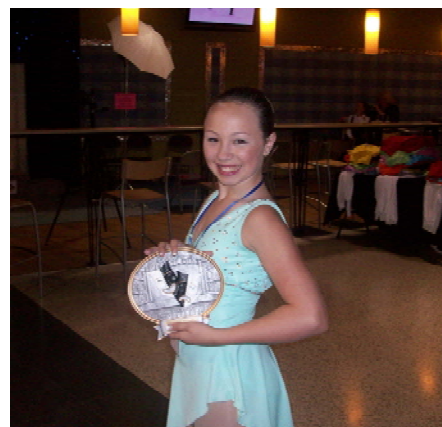
